
HOME Hanging Bead (adding a bead to the base of a ring or split ring to sit below it)




The following shows how to add a bead to the base of a ring or a split ring so that it can be joined to another element later in the piece of tatting.


Work ring or split ring as normal but do not close.



Pull the core thread of the ring through the bead and put safety pin in place to hold it until needed.



Keeping bead close to the last ds worked close ring.



When you reach the place in the pattern where you join to the 'hanging down' bead then remove the safety pin and make a join. You can either use the working shuttle or shuttle two (if you are working another split ring) to put through the loop/picot at the base of the bead.
