Val's Pearl Tatted Basket



This pattern is worked using the Fast and Easy Pearl tatting method. See this link. http://www.e.n.e.btinternet.co.uk/PearlTatting.pdf

The single chain is tatted in four sections. Section 1 basket handle, section 2 basket, section 3 back basket rim and section 4 the front basket rim. DNRW at any stage

Three shuttles - thread size 20.

Abbreviations

R ring P Ch Pearl chain

B Double worked on the top of the thread b Double worked on the bottom of the thread

Cl close Sh1 Shuttle one

Sh2 Shuttle two

All rings are $(1 -) \times 5 1 \text{ Cl}$

Make a ring with each of the three threads.

P Ch section 1: Pinch 3 threads together at base of rings (B b) x 3, (B B b) x 15, (B b) x 3

R, SH1, as above

R, SH2, as above

P Ch section 2: $(B b) \times 6$, $(B B b) \times 15$, $(B b) \times 6$

Join the chain to the beginning of the work being careful not to twist it. I did this by simply passing the core thread from front to back through the centre of the core thread ring.

P Ch section 3: b (B b B b) x 8

Lock join Sh1 thread to the core thread lying between the two rings on the right hand side of the basket

P Ch section 4: B b (B - B b) \times 12 B b.

Tie and cut.
