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Note - Leave beads on shuttle until required (unless otherwise stated) and then move into place. All doodles are made with threads wound CTM again unless stated otherwise.

## Materials required

Size 20 thread with two size 10 BLACK seed beads and one size 10 white. Two shuttles.

Add beads to thread on the ball in the following order - two black beads followed by the white one. Wind 1 yard onto shuttle 1. Pull off another yard and add that to shuttle 2 (CTM). Before starting make sure beads are on shuttle 1 .

Add bead for tooth, then nose and finally eye in that order. Move tooth and nose beads to back of hand before starting.
