

The 'Ribbon' Christmas Tree © Jane Eborall 2012



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This idea stems from trees I've seen made with ribbons. I am only adding two drawings to this pattern as it is very repetitious. You will find that in each 'branch' I have added one more split ring. The diagram shows the first two repeats. The 'beadless' split rings are used to assemble the finished tree. Before starting add 52 seed beads to each shuttle.

Materials required – size 20 thread, seed beads and larger beads for the trunk and topping.

Skills required – a knowledge of split rings and an ability to count!!!

Row 1

R1: 1 vsp 6 vsp 1 Cl bead at back of hand

SR2: 1 + (vsp R1) 2 B 2 vsp 1 / 1 + (vsp R1) 2 MB 2 vsp 1 Cl bead at back of hand

SR3: 1 + (vsp SR2) 2 B 2 vsp 1 / 1 + (vsp SR2) 2 MB 2 vsp 1 Cl bead at back of hand

SR4: 1 + (vsp SR3) 2 B 2 vsp 1 / 1 + (vsp SR3) 2 MB 2 vsp 1 Cl

 SR61: 1 + (vsp SR60) 3 / 1 + (vsp SR60) 3 Cl

To assemble the tree.

Start at the bottom – I use invisible thread. Add the seed bead to the thread. Now take both ends and start adding beads and branches as in figure 2. Which beads you use are your choice but each branch needs one in between. Take the thread through the non beaded R1, SR's 5, 10, 15, 22, 30, 39, 49 & 61. After SR61 add a 'fancy' bead for the star at the top and add a further seed bead. Now tie a knot to keep them all in place and then tie a loop for hanging the tree.


