Small Cupcake © Jane Eborall 2014 Instructions for making into earrings included





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Materials required:- Size 20 thread and size 11 seed beads.

Note – for those who prefer front side/back side tatting the text in italics and red indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the ds first.

Abbreviations

R	ring	Ch	chain
vsp	Very small picot	SLT	Shoe lace trick
RW	Reverse work	DNRW	Do not reverse work
+ B	Add bead to picot while joining		
SCMR	Self closing mock ring	MB	Move bead along thread
BBB	Move three beads into place	Cl	close
T & C	Tie and cut		

Base – 1 shuttle and ball thread – ¾ yard on shuttle for each cupcake.

2 - 1 vsp 1 CI DNRW SLT R1: Ch: 6 SLT RW

Ch: 1 vsp 6 RW 1 + (vsp R1) 1 - 1 vsp 1 Cl SLT DNRW R2:

Ch: 6 Lj (vsp last Ch) SLT RW

Ch: 1 vsp 6 RW R3: 1 + (vsp R2) 1 - 1 vsp 1 Cl SLT DNRW

Ch: 6 Lj (vsp last Ch) SLT RW 7 RW Ch:

R4: 1 + (vsp R3) 1 - 2 Cl T & C

Topping – 2 shuttles – 1 yard on each. Add 5 beads to each shuttle for simple cupcakes and 2 to Sh1 and 6 to Sh2 on each shuttle for earrings.

R5: 2 + B (R4 of base) 2 - 2 - 2 Cl RW

Ch: 2 B 2 B 2 RW SS

SCMR6: 1 + B (last p R5) 2 SS

1 + B (next p R5) 2 + B (R3 on base) 2 - 1 Cl SS

2 - 1 CI SLT RW SCMR6:

For a plain cupcake work the following chain.

Ch: 2 B 2 BBB MB 2 B 2 SS RW

For an earring cupcake work this chain.

Ch: 2 B 2 MB + (earring finding) MB 2 B 2 SS RW

1 + B (SCMR6) 2 SS SCMR7:

> 1 + B (next p SCMR6) 2 + B (R2 on base) 2 - 1 Cl SS R:

2 - 1 CI SLT RW SCMR7:

Ch: 2 B 2 B 2 RW

R8: 2 + B (SCMR7) 2 + B (next p SCMR7) 2 + B (R1 on base) 2 Cl T & C
