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This pattern uses sequins with opposing holes which can be used for a mobile, pendant or even large earrings. Also a new way of making sure they are stable by taking a join between two sequins. No beads are added to the threads before starting. The motif measures 2 ".

Materials required: Size 20 thread, size 13mm diameter sequins (2 for each motif) with holes on opposite sides, size 11 seed beads. For all versions add $21 / 2$ yards to shuttle and work from ball. Note - a single holed sequin can be used and a sharp pin will make the whole in the opposite side.
