Abbreviations

RW R Ch chain CI reverse work close ring

SS switch shuttles verv small picot vsp

Li lock ioin ioin SPCh spiral chain - make the first half of the ds five times then pass the shuttle underneath **both** threads. So for SPCh 3 x 5 make 3 sets of 5 half doubles. **See** this link for further help.

Note: - for those who prefer front side/back side tatting the text in italics and red indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the ds first.

Materials required - size 40 thread and 2 shuttles.



R9: 3 - 3 CI SS


Ch: 3 - 2 Lj (SPCh last row) 2 - 2 - 3 SS

R11: 3-3-3-3-3-3CISS

Ch: 2 - 2 - 2 Lj (SPCh last row) 2 - 2 - 2 SS

R12: 3-3-3-3-3-3-3 CISS

Ch: 2 - 2 (repeat until 13 picots have been made) T & C to top R5



Second side.

Turn work upside down and join to the top vsp on centre ring. Remember (if working front/back side tatting) to reverse the order of working the double stitches. Repeat from start.

Final Row - 1 shuttle and ball thread

With right side facing and the two vsp's of the centre ring at the bottom of the work join threads to base of R12 on first side

Ch: 2 - 2 (repeat until 15 picots have been made) Lj (middle p R12) 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 Lj (middle p R11) 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 Lj (middle p R10) 2 - 2 - 2 Lj (R9) 2 - 2 - 6 Lj (vsp centre R) 2 Lj (next vsp centre R) 6 - 2 - 2 Lj (R9 second half bow) 2 - 2 - 2 Lj (R10) 2 - 2 - 2 Lj (R11) 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 Lj (R12) 2 - 2 (repeat until 15 picots have been made) T & C to base R12.
