Tighten chain and a small picot will be left at the start.

## **Starting Chain with False Picot** © Jane Eborall 2013

This technique shows an easier way to start a chain without a pin to hold a space for joining later in the work. I was shown this by Marie Smith.

Holding the thread in the pinch as if making a regular chain make the **SECOND** half of the double stitch. Don't try to tighten it – just keep a good loop to hold on to.


Next leave a very small picot and make as many regular doubles

Your work should look like this.

(starting with the first half of the stitch) as required.

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
