Skills required - Split rings, self closing mock rings, daisy picot technique and for version 2 - wrapping thread over two others like second side of a split ring.

Materials required - 2 or 3 colours of thread and 2 or 3 shuttles. 2 shuttles for version 1 and 3 for version 2. Also a safety pin/paper clip to make a vsp on the lock chain. Size 20 thread in a dark and light colour. Wind 7 yards onto Sh1, 8¼ yards onto Sh2 and 4½ onto Sh3 for version 2.

Tips

1. [Link for making the Daisy Picot](#)
2. Use a safety pin/paper clip to keep a small vsp at start of lock chains
3. When joining a DPR to a SCMR use the outer colour of the DPR to join - closest to the picot you're joining to.
4. Mark shuttles with their number (1, 2 or 3)

Note – for those who prefer front side/back side tatting the text in *italics and red* indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the ds first.

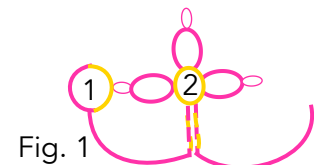

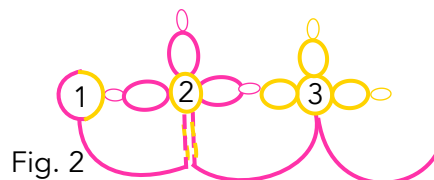

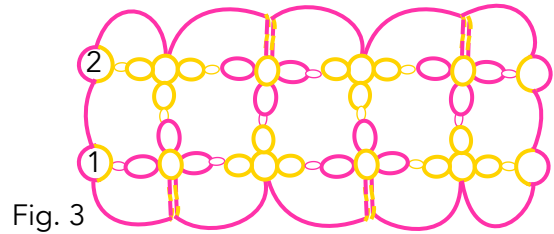

Version 2 - using 3 shuttles

To make wrapped chains hold Sh1 & Sh2 together over the left hand as if working a normal chain. Work over these two threads as if making the second side of a SR starting with second half of ds first (wrapped). Sh1 will form the centre of the flower (DPR) and the SCMR, Sh2 the petals of the DPR and Sh3 the chains.

First end - using Sh1 and hiding all 3 ends.

SR1: 3 vsp 3 / 6 CI DNRW
Ch: 14 (wrapped) then drop Sh3 and using Sh1 RW

LCh: vsp (use safety pin) 4 RW SLT
DPR2: 2 SS 3 + (SR1) 3 SS 2 SS 3 vsp 3 SS 2 SS 3 vsp 3 SS 2 CI
LCh: 4 Lj (vsp last LCh)

* SCMR3: 2 SS

End motif for pearl tatted tail

Hold Sh1 & Sh3 together for first part of next SR with Sh1 thread around the hand.
SR1: 12 / 12 CI and cut Sh3 SLT - using Sh2
SR2: 10 / 10 CI SLT SS
SR3: 6 / 6 CI SLT SS
R4: 8 CI T & C

Version 3 - using 3 shuttles

To make wrapped chains hold Sh1 & Sh2 together over the left hand as if working a normal chain. Work over these two threads as if making the second side of a SR starting with second half of ds first (wrapped). Sh1 will form the centre of the flower (DPR) and the SCMR, Sh2 the petals of the DPR and Sh3 the chains.

First end - using Sh1 and hiding all 3 ends.

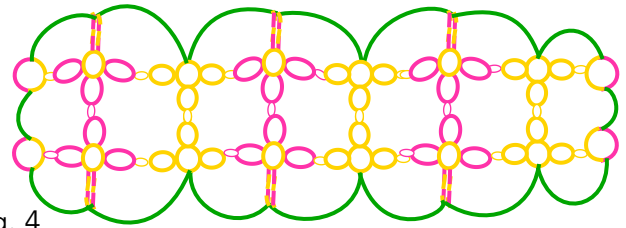
