

Making a Mock Ring © Jane Eborall 2014 Similar to a Self Closing Mock Ring

Take a ball of thread and make a loop leaving a short end (approximately 10") to finger tat with.

Using the end finger tat the number of doubles required. There will probably be picots to make too.

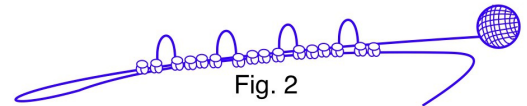

When the required number of doubles and picots are made then take the end you've been working with through the loop at the beginning and pull it to close.

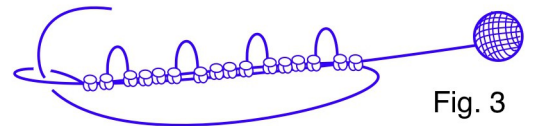

The finished mock ring will look like this.

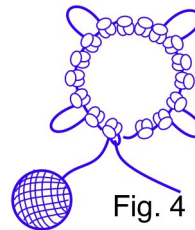
