## HOME



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Materials required:- Number 20 thread, beads and a square metal finding with four joining spaces and measuring $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ - see picture.
Skills required:- knowledge of split ring and lock chain.

## Abreviations

R Ring
SR Split ring
Vsp Very small picot
RW Reverse work
LBP Long beaded picot

LCh Lock chain (first half ds normal, second half 'wrapped' or unflipped).
Note: for those who prefer front side/back side tatting the text in italics and red indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the ds first.
Wind 4 yards onto Sh1 and $21 / 2$ yards on Sh2. Add 3 (or 4 ) beads to Sh2. If you are adding to a metal split ring then only 3 beads are required. Additional beads and can be added using a long beaded picot to the split ring opposite the metal split ring finding. Use Sh1 to start.
Round 1 - see Figs. 1, 2, $3 \& 4$ for joins to finding.

R1: 1 vsp $5+\left(\right.$ fig. $1-1^{\text {st }}$ hole in finding) $1+(f i g .1-$ NEXT hole in finding) 5 vsp 1 Cl
*SR2: $1+(v s p$ R1) 3 vsp $1 / 6 \mathrm{Cl}$
R3: $1+($ vsp SR2) $5+$ (fig. 2 - same hole in finding as last join) 3 vsp 3 Cl RW
Ch: $6-6$ RW
R4: $3+$ (R3) $3+$ (fig. 3 - same hole in finding as last join) 5 vsp 1 Cl
SR5: $1+(v s p ~ R 4) 3$ vsp $1 / 6$ Cl
R6: 1 + (vsp SR5) $5+$ (fig. 4 - same hole in finding as last join) $1+$ (NEXT hole in finding) 5 vsp 1 Cl
Repeat from * three times finishing with SR20 on the final repeat (this is SR5). Join the vsp on SR20 to the vsp on R1. See fig. 5 below.

After closing SR20 join to SR2 with Sh1 thread. DO NOT RW - you will now be working back from the finish of the square to the beginning. SLT \& SS so that Sh2 is the chain thread round the back of the hand.

## Round 2

## Continue with

LCh: 6 + (btwn SR20 \& corner chain) 6 SS bead at back of hand
SR21:4 B $4 / 3+$ B (Ch on last round) 3 Cl SS
LCh: 6 + (btwn R18 \& SR17) 6 + (btwn SR17 \& SR15) 6 + (btwn SR15 \& R14) 6 SS bead at back of hand
SR22: 2 LBP (small seed beads with an accent bead in the middle) 2 B $2+$ (LBP) $2 / 3+B$ (Ch on last round) 3 Cl SS
Continue with LCh as before. Move bead to back of hand and then work SR23 as SR21 and continue again with LCh. Before SR24 SS
SR24: $4+$ metal split ring finding $4 / 3+B$ (Ch on last round) 3 CI SS
Continue with LCh as before finishing in the same place as the round started. T\& C.
