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Note – In all patterns leave beads on shuttle until required (unless otherwise stated) and then move into place. All doodles are made with threads wound CTM again unless stated otherwise.

There are two sizes of rabbits below.

Abbreviations

R Ring S Starting place
- or p Picot SCMR Self closing mock ring
SS Switch shuttles vsp Very small picot
MB Move bead into place

Rabbit - 2 shuttles

2 shuttles (brown) 1 yard on each. 2 beads on Sh2. Starting with lower leg.

SCMR1: 1 vsp 15 vsp 1 SS

Move bead to back of hand before starting R

RA: 1 + (last vsp) 5 Lp (ear) 1 Lp (ear) 2 MB 3 B 3 vsp

1 CI SS

SCMR1: 1 + (vsp R) 2 vsp 1 SS RB: 1 + (vsp SCMR) 3 - 3 vsp 1 Cl SS SCMR1: 1 + (vsp R) 6 vsp 2 Cl SS

R2: 2 + (vsp SCMR1) 3 - 5 Cl T & C

Take a short length of white and take the end through the vsp at the base of the SCMR1. Work ring 3 covering the start end in the first few doubles.

R3: 1-1-1-1-1-1 (5 picots) Cut and sew in end.

Rabbit larger version – 2 shuttles

2 shuttles (brown) 1 yard on Sh1 and $1\frac{1}{2}$ yards on Sh2. 2 beads on Sh2. Starting with lower leg.

SCMR1: 1 vsp 19 vsp 1 SS move bead to back of hand before starting R

RA: 1 + (last vsp) 7 LP (ear) 1 LP (ear) 4 MB 5 B 4 vsp 1 Cl SS

SCMR1: 1 + (vsp R) 4 vsp 1 SS

RB: 1 + (vsp SCMR) 7 - 3 vsp 1 Cl SS SCMR1: 1 + (vsp R) 9 vsp 2 Cl SS

R2: 2 + (vsp SCMR1) 5 - 6 CIT & C

Take a short length of white and take the end through the vsp at the base of the SCMR1. Work ring 3 covering the start end in the first few doubles.

R3: 1-1-1-1-1-1-1-1 (7 picots) Cut and sew in end.
