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Abbreviations

R	ring	Ch	chain
MB	Move bead on core thread	DNRW	Do not reverse work
Cl	close	SS	Switch shuttles
Lp	Long picot (measurement in brackets)	T & C	Tie and cut
Sh1	Shuttle 1	Sh2	Shuttle 2
smp	Small picot		

Materials required

2 shuttles (1 ¼ yards on Sh1 and 1 yard on Sh2) wound CTM. Add 1 red B (nose – size 9 bead) to Sh1 & 2 black beads onto Sh2 (eyes – size 11 beads). Start with Sh1 leaving red bead on shuttle until required. Finished size roughly 3/4”.

NOTE: This pattern can also be worked using the [double double stitch](#). If worked using this method the head will be 'firmer' and will measure 1”. You will need 2 yards on Sh1 and 1 yard on Sh2.

Lower face

R1: 4 vsp 3 MB 3 Cl DNRW SS

Upper face

Ch: 8 MB 3 vsp 1 SS

R2: 1 + (vsp Ch) 2 smp 2 vsp 1 Cl SS

Ch: 1 + (vsp R2) 1 Lp (½”) 1 Lp (¼”) 6 Lp (¼”) 1 Lp (½”) 1 vsp 1 SS

R3: 1 + (vsp Ch) 2 smp 2 vsp 1 Cl SS

Ch: 1 + (vsp R3) 3 MB 8 Lj vsp on R T & C.
