# Garden Snowflake © Jane Eborall 2012 <br> Amended 2019 



When worked in a number 20 thread the motif measures $23 / 4$ " from point to point.
Materials required for each motif. 2 shuttles with $31 / 4$ yards for Sh1 colour (plain) and $31 / 2$ yards of variegated thread on Sh2, size 11 seed beads.

Add 18 beads to Sh1 \& 24 to Sh2 and start with Sh1 (plain).

## Centre

R1: MBBH 2 vsp 1 B 1 vsp 2 CI RW
*Ch: 4 vsp 4 RW
R2: MBBH 2 + (vsp last R) 1 B 1 vsp 2 CI RW
Repeat from * three times
Ch: 4 vsp 4 RW


R6: $2+$ (vsp last R) 1 B 1 + (vsp R1) 2 CI RW
For the Sch do a SLT after the first half to make both halves of the chain the same colour.
Sch: 4/4

## Round 1

When working the SSSR hide the colour you want to carry to this round inside the first half.

R15: MBBH (2 B's) 1 + (vsp last SR) 2 B $2+$ (next Ch on centre) 2 B 2 vsp 1 CI RW SS

SR16: $4 / 1+$ (vsp last R) 3 Cl Repeat from * until SR53 has been worked.
