## **HOME**

# Squared Away © Jane Eborall 2024



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This motif is worked in two parts and measures 2" square when worked in size 20 thread. Several motifs can be joined together using the picots on the final round.

**Skills required:** Knowledge of split rings. The reverse join can be found here.

Materials required: two shuttles and size 20 thread in two different colours.

**Note** – for those who prefer front side/back side tatting the text in *italics and red* indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the ds first.

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Rj reverse join - in the pattern I have not followed this with a RW as the join should naturally make the worker change direction.

## Round 1

Wind 2 yards onto Sh1 then pull off a further 1½ yards, cut from ball and wind onto Sh2.

R1: 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 Cl RW

Ch: 4 DNRW SS

RoCh2: 3 - 3 Cl SS

Ch: 4 RW

SR3: 4-4-4/4 CI SR4: 4-4-4/4 CI RW

Ch: 4 DNRW SS

RoCh5: 3 + (RoCh2) 3 Cl SS

Ch: 4 RW

SR6: 4-4-4/4Cl SR7: 4-4-4/4ClRW

Ch: 4 DNRW SS


RoCh8: 3 + (RoCh2) 3 Cl SS



SR9: 4 - 4 - 4 / 4 Cl SR10: 4 - 4 - 4 / 4 Cl RW

RoCh11: 3 + (RoCh2) 3 CI SS

R12: 4-4-4+(R1) 4 CI T&C

### Round 2

Wind 3 (5 1/4) yards onto Sh1 then pull off a further 3½ (4) yards, cut from ball and wind onto Sh2.

R1: 4 + (2nd p R1 last round) 4 vsp 4 - 4 Cl SS DNRW

Ch: vsp 6 Rj (3rd p R1 last round) RW

Ch: 6 RW

R2: 4 + (vsp base R1) 6 - 4 vsp 2 Cl

R3: 2 + (vsp R2) 6 - 6 vsp 2 Cl

R4: 2 + (vsp R3) 4 - 6 vsp 4 Cl RW

Ch: 6 Rj (1st p SR3 round 1) RW

Ch: 6 + (vsp R4 round 2) SS

SR5: 4 - 4 / 4 + (next p SR3 round 1) 4 Cl

SR6: 4 - 4 / 4 + (next p SR4 round 1) 4 Cl SS

Ch: vsp 6 Rj (3rd p SR4 round 1) RW

Ch: 6 RW

R7: 4 + (vsp base SR6) 6 - 4 vsp 2 Cl

R8: 2 + (vsp R7) 6 - 6 vsp 2 Cl

R9: 2 + (vsp R8) 4 - 6 vsp 4 Cl RW

Ch: 6 Rj (1st p SR6 round 1) RW

Ch: 6 + (vsp R9 round 2) SS

SR10: 4 - 4 / 4 + (next p SR6 round 1) 4 Cl

SR11: 4 - 4 / 4 + (SR7 round 1) 4 Cl SS DNRW

Ch: vsp 6 Rj (next p SR7 round 1) RW

Ch: 6 RW

R12: 4 + (vsp base SR11) 6 - 4 vsp 2 Cl

R13: 2 + (vsp R12) 6 - 6 vsp 2 Cl

R14: 2 + (vsp R13) 4 - 6 vsp 4 Cl RW

Ch: 6 Rj (1st p SR9 round 1) RW

Ch: 6 + (vsp R14 round 2) SS

SR15: 4 - 4 / 4 + (next p SR9 round 1) 4 Cl

SR16: 4 - 4 / 4 + (next p SR10 round 1) 4 Cl SS

Ch: vsp 6 Rj (3rd p SR10 round 1) RW

Ch: 6 RW

R17: 4 + (vsp base SR16) 6 - 4 vsp 2 Cl

R18: 2 + (vsp R17) 6 - 6 vsp 2 Cl

R19: 2 + (vsp R18) 4 - 6 vsp 4 Cl RW

Ch: 6 Rj (1st p R12 round 1) RW

Ch: 6 + (vsp R19 round 2) SS

R20: 4 - 4 + (R1 round 2) 4 + (next p R12 round 1) 4 Cl
