 SR43: 1 + (vsp SR42) 2 vsp 1 / 5 Cl
 SR44: 1 + (vsp SR43) 3 / 5 Cl + (vsp R34) using the thread closest to the picot. RW
Ch: 4 Lj (vsp R33) 4 Lj (vsp R32) 5 Lj (vsp R31) 4 Lj (space btwn R1 & SR2) T & C.


