


Abbreviations

vsp	Very small picot	Ch	Chain
Lj	Lock join	SLT	Shoe lace trick
TW	Turn work from left to right (as in turning pages of book)	CTM	Continuous thread method
SR	Split ring		

Make sure you have 3 ¼ yards of thread on shuttle 1 and 4 yards on shuttle 2 – CTM.

Note – for those who prefer front side/back side tatting the text in italics and red indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the ds first

Join to vsp on SR6 by taking a loop up through the vsp on SR6 and passing both shuttles through the loop. See diagrams below.



Ch1: 1 vsp 6 Lj (vsp SR7) vsp 6 Lj (vsp SR8) 1 SLT TW
Ch2: 1 vsp 7 Lj (vsp Ch1) vsp 7 Lj (vsp Ch1) 1 SLT TW
 Ch3: 1 vsp 8 Lj (vsp Ch2) vsp 8 Lj (vsp Ch2) 1 SLT TW
Ch4: 1 vsp 8 Lj (vsp Ch3) vsp 8 Lj (vsp Ch3) SLT TW
 Ch5: 1 vsp 7 Lj (vsp Ch4) vsp 7 Lj (vsp Ch4) SLT TW


