Make sure you have $31 / 4$ yards of thread on shuttle 1 and 4 yards on shuttle 2 - CTM.
Note - for those who prefer front side/back side tatting the text in italics and red indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the ds first

Join to vsp on SR6 by taking a loop up through the vsp on SR6 and passing both shuttles through the loop. See diagrams below.
