SR	split ring	Cl	close	Lj	lock join
vsp	very small picot	SS	switch shuttles	T & C	tie, cut and hide ends
AJ	alligator join.				

An alligator join is where you take one thread in front of the joining place (in this case the small gap between R1 and SR2) and one thread behind. In this pattern you immediately do a shoelace trick and reverse work after the AJ. Sounds complicated but take each step at a time.

Continue with

- Ch: 4 Lj (vsp R2) 3 AJ SLT RW (around the join between R1 and SR2) 4 Lj (vsp R1) SS
- SR6: 4 / 4 Cl
- SR7: 4 / 4 Cl
- SR8: 3 / 3 Cl T & C

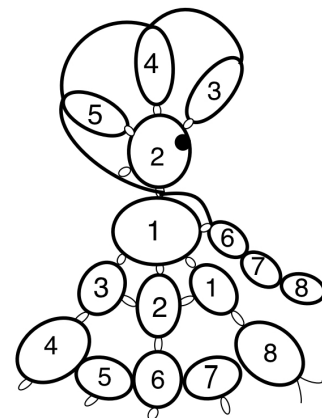
