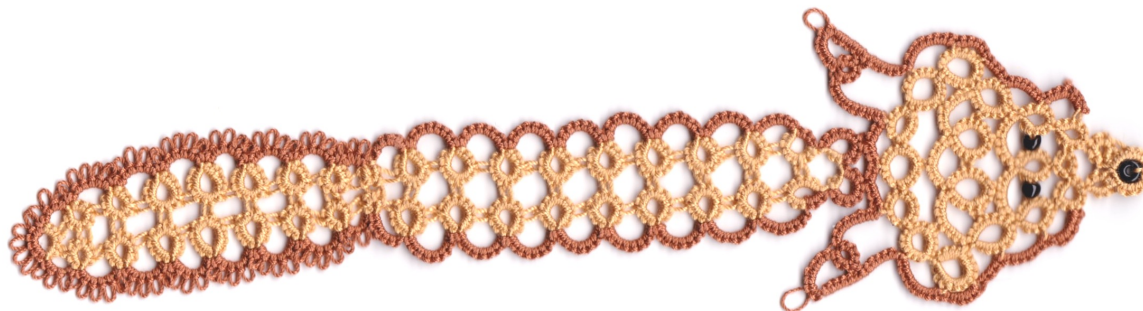


This is the final day. Meet your foxy bookmark!!!

Abbreviations for today are

RW	reverse work	SLT	shoe lace trick	Ch	chain
SR	split ring	Lj	lock join	vsp	very small picot
+	join	T & C	tie and cut		

Note – for those who prefer front side/back side tatting the text in *italics and red* indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the ds first.

- Ch: 8 RW
- R2: 4 vsp 3 Cl RW*
- Ch: 6 - 1 SLT RW
- Ch: 6 + (R2) 6 + (SR15) SLT RW*
- Ch: 8 Lj (SR14) 5 Lj (next vsp SR14) 3 Lj (SR13)
- 6 Lj (SR7) 6 LJ (SR6) T & C

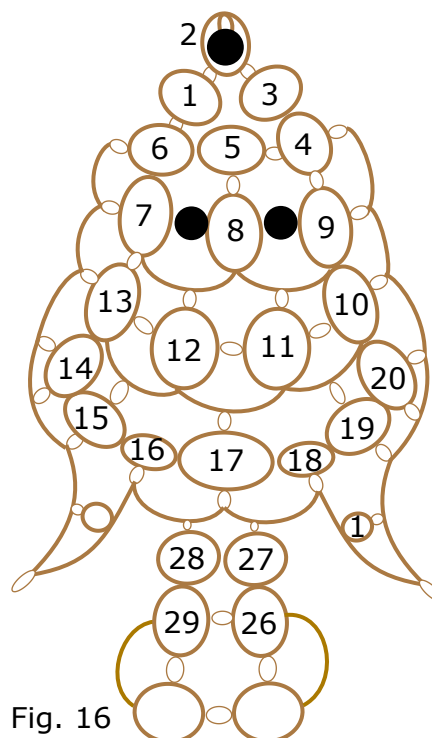
