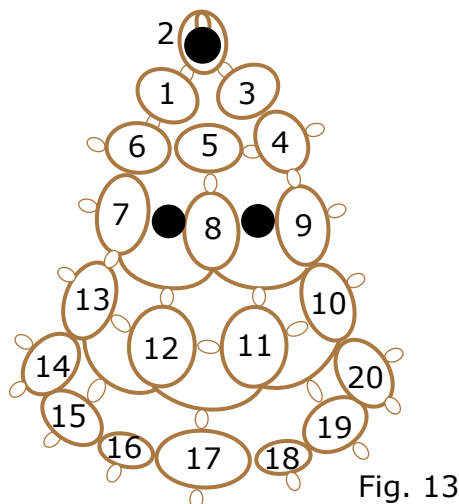
**Note** – for those who prefer front side/back side tatting the text in *italics and red* indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the ds first.

- R13: 4 + (R12) 4 + (vsp @ base SR7) 4 vsp 4 Cl DNRW*
- SR14: 4 vsp 4 vsp 4 / 4 Cl DNRW*
- SR15: 4 vsp 4 / 4 + (Ch between R12 & R13) 4 Cl*
- SR16: 3 vsp 3 / 6 Cl*
- SR17: 4 vsp 4 / 4 + (Ch between SR12 & R11) 4 Cl*
- SR18: 3 vsp 3 / 6 Cl*
- SR19: 4 vsp 4 / 4 + (Ch between R11 & SR10) 4 Cl RW SS*
- R20: 4 + (base SR10) 4 vsp 4 vsp 4 Cl T & C

Preparation for day 14

Using darker colour of thread wind 2 yards onto a shuttle but **do not cut from the ball.**
