Note – for those who prefer front side/back side tatting the text in *italics and red* indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the ds first.

R33: 3 + (R32) 3 + (R22) 3 - 3 Cl RW

Ch: 8 RW

R34: 3 + (R33) 3 + (R21) 3 - 3 CI RW

Ch: 8 RW

R35: 3 + (R34) 3 + (R20) 3 - 3 Cl RW

Ch: 8 RW

R36: 3 + (R35) 3 + (R19) 3 - 3 Cl RW

Ch: 8 RW

R37: 3 + (R36) 3 + (R18) 2 + (R1) 4 CI RW

Ch: 6 T&C to base R1



Preparation for Day 10

For this part of the TIAS you will be using the same colour thread on both shuttles.

Also required - 3 size 10 or 11 seed beads.

Add 1 of the beads to the ball thread and wind $2\frac{1}{2}$ yards on Sh1. Pull off $2\frac{1}{2}$ yards from the ball and cut. Wind this onto Sh2. Before starting make sure that the bead is still on Sh1 and ready to be used in the second ring.
