

**Abbreviations for today are**

R ring            Ch chain            Cl close            - or p picot  
RW reverse work            + join

**Note** – for those who prefer front side/back side tatting the text in *italics and red* indicates where the worker needs to use the second half of the ds first.

- R32: 3 + (R31) 3 + (R23) 3 - 3 Cl RW  
*Ch: 8 RW*
- R33: 3 + (R32) 3 + (R22) 3 - 3 Cl RW  
*Ch: 8 RW*
- R34: 3 + (R33) 3 + (R21) 3 - 3 Cl RW  
*Ch: 8 RW*
- R35: 3 + (R34) 3 + (R20) 3 - 3 Cl RW  
*Ch: 8 RW*
- R36: 3 + (R35) 3 + (R19) 3 - 3 Cl RW  
*Ch: 8 RW*
- R37: 3 + (R36) 3 + (R18) 2 + (R1) 4 Cl RW  
*Ch: 6 T&C to base R1*

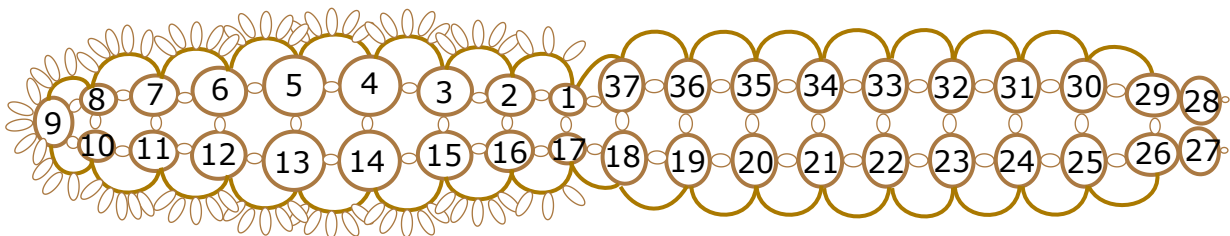

**Preparation for Day 10**

For this part of the TIAS you will be using the same colour thread on both shuttles.

Also required - 3 size 10 or 11 seed beads.

Add 1 of the beads to the ball thread and wind 2½ yards on Sh1. Pull off 2½ yards from the ball and cut. Wind this onto Sh2. Before starting make sure that the bead is still on Sh1 and ready to be used in the second ring.
